**Do not put recyclables in garbage bags, which are considered household waste...use CLEAR/TRANSPARENT bags**  
**If any of the bins are full, please leave the recyclables or packaged waste beside the appropriate bin.**

<b>Household Waste</b>	Food wastes, waxed cardboard
<b>Mixed Fibres</b> (Paper Products)	Old box board (detergent/laundry cartons, cracker/biscuit boxes, tissue/shoe boxes) Fibre egg cartons and egg flats (made from recycled paper) Residential household paper (newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, computer paper, telephone books) Corrugated cardboard (shipping boxes) – FLATTEN boxes and cut to 30" x 30" if oversize
<b>Containers</b> (Metal, glass, plastic) Size: 1 foot X 2 feet maximum  DO NOT include plastic pools, large plastic pails, plastic pipe, vinyl siding, plastic chairs, plastic tables, etc.	Empty paint cans (max. 4 litre size, no liquid, max. 5mm dried paint in bottom)- REMOVE COVER Polycoat (wax) cartons (milk cartons, juice and other beverage cartons) Aluminum trays and foil Polystyrene (Styrofoam) (clean bakery and meat trays, foam cups, fast food trays) Glass, clear and coloured bottles and jars (please rinse containers) Metal food and beverage cans (please rinse containers) Rigid plastic containers (bleach bottles, juice, shampoo, etc.)

Please take your Household Hazardous Waste products to the MacFarlane Street Transfer Station in the Town of Parry Sound. (Directions: From Bowes Street take Great North Road; at Emily Street turn right; at MacFarlane Street turn left. The Transfer Station is located at the end of MacFarlane Street). Residents of the Township of the Archipelago will not be charged a fee for dropping off Household Hazardous Wastes at this Transfer Station.

### Household Hazardous Waste – Acceptable Items (All products must have readable labels)

<b>Corrosive</b>	Batteries, car batteries, acids, drain cleaners, oven cleaners
<b>Flammable</b>	Paints, solvents, oils BBQ starter, propane cylinders
<b>Toxic</b>	Pesticides, rat poison, pharmaceuticals, cleaning fluids, antifreeze, detergents
<b>Reactive</b>	Ammonia, bleach, pool chemicals
<b>Other</b>	Fluorescent tubes, light bulbs
